





50 YEARS OF HISTORY

ON NOVEMBER 20, 1956, A CROWD OF 3000 WATCHED AS THE NEW SCOTTSBURG-VIENNA TOWNSHIP SCHOOL BUILDING AND GYMNASIUM WAS DEDICATED. L. V. PHILLIPS, WHO WAS COMMISSIONER OF THE IHSAA AT THE TIME, WAS THE MAIN SPEAKER THAT EVENING.

AS WE NEAR THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THAT DEDICA-TION, A COMMITTEE HAS FORMED TO REMODEL THE LOBBY OF WHAT WE NOW CALL MEYER GVM, NAMED FOR HALL OF FAME MEMBER CHARLES E. MEYER.

IN THE 50 YEARS THAT MEYER GYM HAS NOW BEEN USED, FANS HAVE WATCHED 3 FINAL FOUR WARRIORETTE TEAMS, ONE THAT WAS RUNNER-UP IN '86 AND ONE THAT WON STATE IN '89. THEY HAVE WITNESSED THREE WARRIOR SQUADS MAKE IT TO THE SWEET SIXTEEN DURING OPEN CLASS BASKETBALL AND TWO MAKE IT TO THE ELITE EIGHT UNDER CLASS BASKETBALL. THERE HAVE BEEN 7 INDIANA GIRL ALL-STARS AND ONE INDIANA BOYS ALL-STAR PLAY ON THE FLOOR AS WELL AS 3 HALL OF FAME COACHES WHO COACHED ON THE FLOOR. DURING THAT TIME, MUCH OF THE HISTORY OF SCOTTS-BURG BASKETBALL WAS KEPT IN THE WEST END LOBBY, BUT OVER TIME, SOME MEMORABILIA HAS BEEN LOST AND SOME HAS EVEN BEEN DAMAGED.

THE MEYER LOBBY RENOVATION COMMITTEE HAS STARTED A GRANITE STONE PROJECT TO HELP RAISE MONEY FOR THE REMODELING PROJECT.
